Singer-guitarist Charlie Moon; Ireland's "*rising star*" of jazz ~ The Irish Times, has been referred to as the Emerald Isle's answer to 'The Prince of Cool' - Chet Baker, working mainly in the cool jazz, blues and soul jazz idioms. Taking after his father Nigel Mooney on guitar, "*Ireland's King of the blues*" ~ BBC, Charlie became notable for playing a melodic guitar style mixing rhythmically swinging bebop & blues, drawing influence from the likes of Wes Montgomery and Peter Bernstein as well as singing styles such as that of '*The Divine One*' - Sarah Vaughan and the aforementioned Chet Baker, conveying a strong storytelling quality in his delivery.
